Jerri Turney Cook, Special Education School Teacher, passed at her home in Fort Gibson, Oklahoma on February 10, 2019 at the young age of 49.

Jerri was born July 27, 1969 in Tahlequah, Oklahoma to Lon and Barbara Turney. She graduated from Tahlequah High School in 1987, then graduated from Northeastern State University with a bachelor's degree in Special Education. She taught for thirteen years and retired from teaching to stay at home to take care of her children. She owned and operated Gibson's Car Wash. She loved taking care of Logan, Madalyn, and husband, Kelly and always called Logan her "blessing." Jerri enjoyed crocheting, (especially for new babies), junking for priceless antiques, rescuing animals, and socializing on Facebook. She was passionate about helping others that had children with the same diagnosis as Logan.
