Allan John Kosloski, 69, changed his earthly address to his heavenly home on December 6th, 2025.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Duanne Kosloski and Shirley Kosloski; his siblings, Steven Kosloski, Marilyn Saltou, and Kevin Kosloski; and his son, Joshua A. Kosloski.

Even when his body was tired and worn from battling cancer, Allan continued to look out for his girls.
