



## Barbara Ann "Bobbie" Clayton

December 29, 1936 - June 1, 2021

Barbara Ann "Bobbie" (Hulet) Clayton, 84, was born December 29, 1936 at the old Baptist Hospital in Muskogee, Oklahoma to William and Agnes (Dodson) Hulet and peacefully passed away Tuesday, June 1, 2021 at her home in Muskogee, with her two favorite nieces and loving husband by her side.
