Bobby Lee Moydell, 90, of Muskogee, was born March 28, 1933, in Fort Gibson to Frank Claude and Annis Sarah (Raines) Moydell, and peacefully passed away Wednesday, April 12, 2023, at his home with his loving family at his bedside. He received his education and graduated from El Camino High School in Sacramento, California. Bob proudly enlisted in the United States Navy on December 2, 1952, and was honorably discharged on March 31, 1959. On August 31, 1957, he married his best friend, Martha Ahrens, in Reno, Nevada. Bob and Martha shared more than 65 years making precious memories together. He worked as an Aerial Photographer for McClellan Air Force Base in California. Bob loved working outside on his property. He excelled at golfing, with 13 holes-in-one confirmed, and was invited to play in the Pan Am Hawaiian Open in the 1960s. Bob was extremely devoted to his family, and had unconditional love as a husband and father. He was very giving to others, always wanting to help anyone who was in need. Bob was a faithful member of the First Baptist Church in Muskogee. He was loved dearly and will be missed by many.
