Bobbie Lea (Woody) Stark, 85 of Muskogee, Oklahoma entered Heavens Gates, Wednesday, May 4, 2016 at her home in Muskogee, Oklahoma surrounded by her family. She was born August 19, 1930 in Larned, Kansas to E.O. and Agnes Woody. She was the fourth of seven children. She grew up in Dyess, Arkansas. After recovering from polio, she played basketball in high school. She married the love of her life, Kelly Bly Stark on October 9, 1950. To this union two sons were born, Kelly and Ron. Bly as he was known to her and his family, passed this life September 9, 1998 after 48 years of marriage. Before her retirement, Bobbie worked for 33 years as the office manager for The Beckman Company Insurance Agency in Muskogee. Bobbie loved the Lord and was a faithful member of the Chandler Road Church of Christ from its inception. She loved to cook and loved watching basketball, especially the Sooners, Razorbacks and the Oklahoma Thunder.

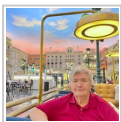
