Bobby Andrew Gillispie, 70, passed away at the VA Medical Center in Muskogee, OK on Wednesday, March 1, 2017. He was born on October 13, 1946 in Fort Gibson, OK to Elmer and Ella Mae (Raper) Gillispie. Bob graduated from Fort Gibson High School in 1964.

Bob was a U.S. Army Veteran, serving in Vietnam from 1967-1968. He earned the Good Conduct Medal, Combat Infantry Badge, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Air Medal, and Marksman M-14 Badge. Bob received an honorable discharge in 1969.

He worked at American Foundry for almost 17 years before retiring in 2004.

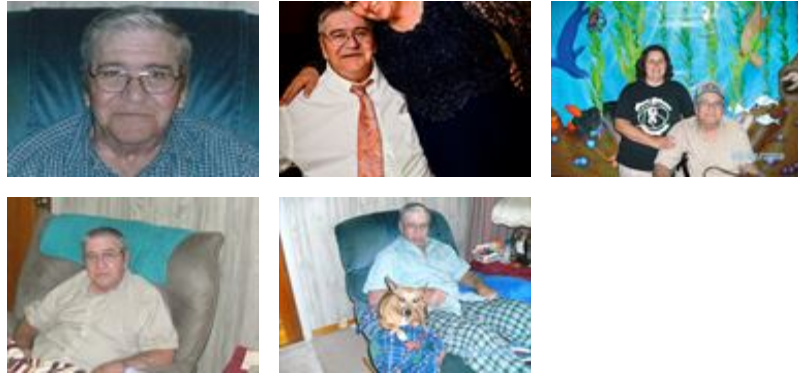
