Bobby Gene Trusley, age 68, of Jacksonville, NC, formerly of Mannford, OK, was born March 28, 1949 in Oklahoma City, OK to James Andrew Trusley and Helen Marie (Main) McDaniel and peacefully passed away Friday, July 7, 2017 in Jacksonville, NC with his loving family by his side.

Bobby grew up in the Tulsa area where he received his formal education. He continued his education and completed a Bachelor's degree in Business. Bobby joined the United States Army in 1967 and proudly served two tours in Vietnam. He had the privilege to serve one tour alongside his father. Bobby received the Vietnam Service Medal with one Silver Star and one Bronze Star, Infantry Badge, Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Cross with Palm Unit Citation Badge Commendations. He received an honorable discharge on April 1, 1975. Bobby was a lifetime member of VFW Post 7441 in Mannford as well as VFW Post 9133 in Jacksonville, NC. He continued his service with the Veterans Administration working as a Disability Claims Representative. Bobby was a generous man and never met a stranger. He enjoyed classic rock, watching 3D movies, traveling, spending time at the beach, eating a Snickers and his favorite ice cream. He enjoyed riding his Harley and driving his convertible so he could feel the wind in his hair. He is and always will be considered a big fish in a small pond to his family and friends.
