Bobby (Bob) Wilks was born to Mannie and Lois Wilks on September 20, 1937, in Fort Gibson. He was raised on the Grand River by his grandparents, Press and Lettie Cooper. He graduated from Fort Gibson High School in 1956, where he was active in Vo Ag and was an excellent basketball and baseball player.

After high school he went to work for Getty Oil Co. and played first base and pitched for the company softball team. He married his high school sweetheart, Ann Sheffield, and they raised four children together. He purchased and operated a backhoe for several years before going to work for the Town of Ft. Gibson. After retiring from the city, he managed and worked for several rural water districts in the area.

In the mid 70's he bought a ski boat and the "Wildwood years" began. All summer and many evenings were spent on Ft. Gibson Lake pulling kids behind his boat.

The Wilks backyard was locally famous for weekend volleyball games. It started in fun and quickly turned into a lighted court, permanently marked boundaries and lots of friendly (mostly) arguments.

Bob was always tinkering on and building things. His truck could only be compared to Mary Poppins' magic bag, if you needed anything it was in there.

He later met and married Billie Ballew and they spent many happy years together enjoying their grandchildren and great grandchildren.

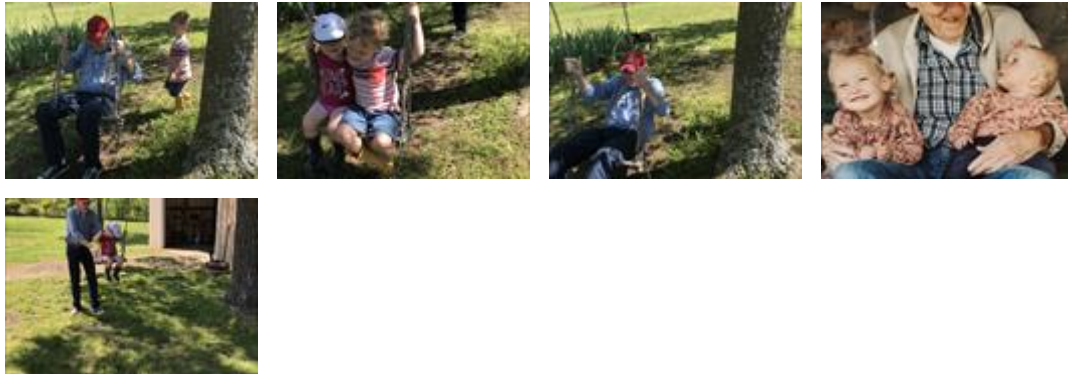
