Byran Avery Radebaugh, 37, of Muskogee, OK was born April 12, 1986, in Muskogee, OK to Byran and Tammy (Boswell) Radebaugh and went to be at home with our Lord on Wednesday, May 24, 2023, in Muskogee.

Byran graduated from Fort Gibson High School and was currently working on his Bachelor's Degree. He became a Marine on June 6, 2005. Byran served as a Rifleman for four years and seven months, and then as a Marine Corps Security Force Guard for two years and four months, earning the Marine Corps Good Conduct Medal, Joint Service Achievement Medal, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (2nd Award), Iraq Campaign Medal (w/I Bronze Star Service), Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal (Kuwait), Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Rifle Qualification Badge (Expert 3rd Award) and Pistol Qualification Badge (Sharpshooter). He was honorably released from active duty on June 5, 2010, but Corporal Radebaugh will always be a Marine. He maintained the cemetery grounds as a Cemetery Caretaker at Fort Gibson National Cemetery for a few years. Byran loved everything outdoors. He would go on hikes deep into the woods to connect with nature. Byran would camp out under the stars, so he could be next to the river early for fishing the next morning. His expert Rifle and sharpshooter pistol qualifications made him an excellent marksman for when he went hunting. Byran could be found on a golf course swinging clubs from time to time, but baseball was his game and the Texas Rangers was his team. When it was time to slow down, Byran would get a pile of coals burning

on his smoker or grill and spend time cooking beef and pork for him and his family.

Byran is preceded in death by his grandfather, Marvin M. Boswell; grandmother, Rudean Radebaugh; great-grandparents, Vester and Opal Allison and Cyrus and Hazel Boswell; and uncles, James M. Boswell and Dennis Radebaugh.

He is lovingly survived by his parents, Tammy and Byran E. Radebaugh; son, Haiden Radebaugh of Muskogee; daughter, Haley Radebaugh; brothers, Cody Radebaugh and wife, Carrie of Muskogee and Daniel Radebaugh of Norman; sister, Chasady Hall and husband, Caleb of Norman; nanny, Nancy Graves; nephews, Keagan Radebaugh of Muskogee, Ares Hall of Norman, Stark Radebaugh of Norman and Zaiden Walls of Muskogee; niece, Zelda Radebaugh of Norman and Zaila Walls of Muskogee; aunts, uncles, cousins, and many friends.

Viewing for Byran will be Wednesday, May 31, 2023, from 12PM to 7PM at Clifford D Garrett Family Funeral Home in Fort Gibson.
