Charles Robert Mutch III, 78, of Fort Gibson, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday, April 30, 2025, surrounded by his family. He was born on March 22, 1947, in Westfield, New York, to Charles and Frances (Riscile) Mutch.

After graduating from high school, Charles pursued higher education at Duke University in North Carolina. He went on to dedicate more than five decades of his life to healthcare as a Physician Assistant before retiring. His commitment to the medical profession extended beyond clinical practice—he was a founding board member of the Northeastern State University Physician Assistant program, helping shape the future of healthcare education in the region.

Charles was deeply involved in his community. He served on both local and state school boards and was an active member of several civic and faith-based organizations. As a devoted parishioner of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Muskogee, he also contributed his time and leadership to the Knights of Columbus, where he served as a former Grand Knight. His passion for service extended into the arts as well; he founded both adult and children's community theater programs and served as their director, enriching the cultural life of Muskogee and the surrounding areas.

He was also a proud member of the Kiwanis Club, consistently working to improve the lives of those around him through service and outreach.

Charles leaves behind a legacy marked by dedication, compassion, and a

profound love for his family and community. His contributions will be remembered by all who had the privilege to know him.
