



## Danny E. Whitworth

Danny E. Whitworth, 81, of Fort Gibson, Oklahoma, was born on July 5, 1944, to Roy Thomas and Grace Irene (Atchison) Whitworth in Wade, Oklahoma. He passed away peacefully on Friday, April 24, 2026, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, with his family by his bedside.

After graduating high school, Danny enlisted in the United States Army in November 1963. He served his country honorably until November 1965, earning an Honorable Discharge. On January 28, 1967, Danny married the love of his life, Iris Kathleen Nichols. Their union spanned over 59 years and was a testament to enduring love and commitment.

Danny and Kathy lived in Dallas, Irving, and Euless, Texas, before making their home in Fort Gibson for the past 52 years. Danny worked as a truck driver for Consolidated Freight for over 27 years before retiring in 2000. He was a dedicated member of the First Baptist Church in Fort Gibson, where he served as a Deacon and Sunday School teacher. His faith and service were central to his life.

In addition to his professional and spiritual commitments, Danny was active with the Teamster's Local 886 and served as a Boy Scouts Troop Leader for Troop 638. He found joy in golfing, fishing, and solving word search puzzles. Danny's life was marked by devotion to his family, faith, and community.

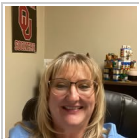
