Earl Nicholas Nicodin, 81, of Muskogee, Oklahoma was born September 24, 1944, in Brown City, Michigan, to Nicholas and Irene (Hilliker) Nicodin and passed away Sunday, December 28, 2025, in Muskogee.

Earl dedicated his life to his family and his work, making significant contributions to his community. Furthering his education at the University of Michigan, he lived in Brown City, Michigan, for 31 years, before moving to Muskogee, Oklahoma, where he spent 50 years until the time of his passing. For 40 of those years, Earl operated Earl's Lake Country RV, a business that served many. On September 11, 1965, he married the love of his life, Shirley, with whom he shared a lifelong partnership and raised three wonderful children. This marriage stood the test of time, lasting 60 years, 3 months, and 17 days until his passing. 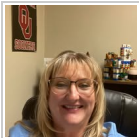
