June 12, 1924 - September 2, 2019

Frank Garcia, 95 of Henryetta, OK was born June 12, 1924 in Bastrop, Texas to Juan and Lola (Quellar) Garcia and passed away peacefully Monday, September 2, 2019 at his home in Henryetta, Oklahoma.

On April 20, 1943 at the age of 19 years old he enlisted in the United States Army, he fought in WWII, receiving the EAME Campaign Medal with 3 Bronze Stars, Good Conduct Medal, Purple Heart Award, Silver Star Medal/Meritorious Unit Award and World War II Victory Medal. Frank received an honorable discharge on November 23, 1945.

After returning home from the war he was hired as a foreman for an agriculture company. As a migrant worker, he, along with his family traveled constantly following the harvest so he could provide for his family. Frank was a hard worker and had many who looked up to him with great respect.

At the age of 75, he retired and enjoyed taking road trips with his wife, Sabrina of 55 years. He enjoyed reading old western books and watching classic western movies on TV. Frank was a humble Christian man who was always there for his family. He had a great sense of humor and loved the outdoors, working with cattle and horses and fishing.

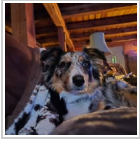
