



Gloria June Hayward

June 29, 1938 - November 12, 2016

Gloria June Hayward 78, of Muskogee, OK left this world Saturday, November 12, 2016 after a short battle with cancer. Gloria was born June 29, 1938 in Indianapolis, IN, where she was the fourth child (of seven) born to Raymond and M. Edith (McLoud) Stahl. Gloria grew up with her family in Indiana, losing her father at the young age of twelve. When she was fifteen she fibbed to the state of Indiana stating on her marriage certificate from Bloomington, IN, that "June" Stahl was 17 and of age when she eloped with Harold (Gene) Hayward, 21. During their life shared together, until their eventual divorce in 1968, Gloria and Gene raised their fast growing young family in Indiana (until 1959) New Orleans, LA, before finally settling in California in 1961. In 1969, Gloria returned back to her birth state of Indiana along with her five children until she moved permanently to Muskogee, OK in 1977. When Gloria wasn't busy taking care of her children and being super grandma to the next generation of young Haywards, she was helping get everyone off to school and to activities before returning to work each night, working as a CNA/CMA healthcare provider for the Nevitts, at Pleasant Valley Nursing Home, a position which she held for over 34 years (only leaving for a short time to care for her ailing mother, Edith in Indiana, before coming back to Oklahoma) and finally retiring in 2013.

Gloria had a wicked sense of humor, a ready laugh, an open door to all, and a love that knew no bounds. She worked hard all her life, gave all she had everyday, lived life to the fullest, and would do anything for anyone, anytime

only asking in return that she get her daily dose of Perry Mason, Wheel of Fortune, Jeopardy, and her other weekly programs like Walker Texas Ranger. She will be missed by anyone that knew her, but especially her family where she had the gift to make each and everyone of them feel like they were the most favored, most important, maybe even the only one in this world that mattered to her. 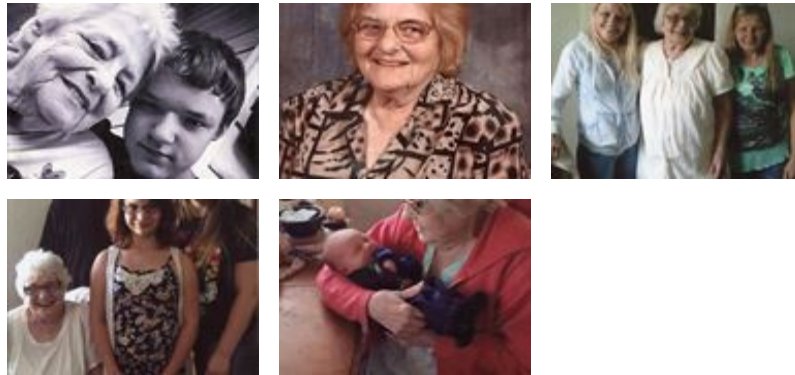
