Helen Millie (Carman) Satterfield was born October 21, 1939 in Okay, Oklahoma to William A. and Virginia (Ford) Carman, and greeted Jesus and all the loved ones who had gone before her on Tuesday, January 18, 2022. Helen's family moved to Fort Gibson when she was 2 years old, and she made her home there for the rest of her life. She graduated from Fort Gibson High School in 1957, and married the love of her life, Leon Satterfield, on November 6, 1958.

She was a homemaker, but also worked as a commercial fisherman with her dad, and then her husband until the late 1970's. It was a heritage she was very proud of.

Helen was a long-time member of the Frank Gladd Unit #20 American Legion Auxiliary in Fort Gibson. She was also a faithful member of New Life Assembly of God in Fort Gibson, where she had many dear friends.

She enjoyed cooking, cookbooks, canning, giving to and helping others, and was well known for her God-given gift and ministry of sending cards to others that arrived at just the right time, and said just the right thing.

Helen was a very talkative and friendly person who could talk to anyone and was known for her many amusing "old sayings". She also enjoyed keeping a daily journal, going to the Senior Center, hunting bargains, "rummage" sales, and was well known for writing dates on almost everything she bought. She maintained a sharp memory throughout most of her life.

husband Leon; brothers Jay Carman, John Carman, and George Carman; sisters Faye Cooper and Ruth Huitt, 3 infant siblings, and son-in-law, Bob Gillispie.
