Herbert Lee Jestice, 75, of Muskogee, was born July 29, 1942 in Sand Springs, Oklahoma to Clabern and Anna Lee (Weaver) Jestice and passed away peacefully Tuesday, May 29, 2018 in Muskogee.

He grew up in Sand Springs and graduated from Charles Page High School. He spent many summers in Porum with his grandparents. His passion was working on old cars.

In 1961 Herbert joined the United States Army during the Vietnam Era and was honorably discharged in October 1962.

When Herbert was 30 years old he returned to college in San Bernardino Valley, California area and made the wrestling team. He loved hot rods, car shows and was a baseball coach for many years

Herbert was a welder by trade and helped build OG&E, Fort Howard in Muskogee and many other manufacturing plants.
