Jerry Henry Schoonover, known to his friends as “Schoon”, passed from this life on Saturday, October 12, 2024. 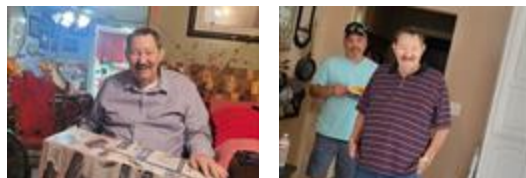
