Jimmy (Jim) Doyne Brazear, 77, of Tahlequah, OK was born May 21, 1941 in Conway, AR to Julian and Willa Mae (Duncan) Brazear and peacefully passed away June 29, 2018 in Broken Arrow, OK with his family by his side.

Jim grew up in Conway where he attended school. He joined the United States Army on June 20, 1961 where he served in the 806 Engineering Co and received an Honorable Discharge on January 31, 1967 with a rank of SP5. On September 15, 1962 he married his best friend Barbara Strack and they lived in Arkansas and Oklahoma with the last 18 years in Tahlequah.
