Jimmy Leon Malone, 75, of Bixby, Oklahoma, was born on October 22, 1949, to Lunda and Eula (Williams) Malone in Miami, Oklahoma, and passed away at his home on Wednesday, November 6, 2024, in Bixby, Oklahoma, with his loving family by his side.

Jimmy spent his career as a dedicated meat cutter for over 40 years, working at Warehouse Market and later at Target. Known for his skill and hard work, he retired in 2015, leaving behind a legacy of dedication and respect in his profession. Jimmy was a proud Navy veteran, and he served his country with honor.
