Lee Roy Smart Jr., 86, was born January 1, 1929 in Maud, OK to Lee Roy Smart and Elsie Loraine (Phillips) Smart and joined his Heavenly Father on Tuesday, February 10, 2015 in Muskogee, OK.

Lee grew up in Maud where he attended school. He joined the United States Navy in March of 1946 and received an honorable discharge in May of 1948. Lee loved the military and joined the United States Army in August of 1949 and also received an honorable discharge in December 1952. Upon completing his military duties, Lee made his home in Oklahoma City and started his own business selling water softener systems. Lee moved to Grenada, Mississippi where his business excelled and where he lived over 25 years. Lee moved back to Oklahoma in 2013, settling in Fort Gibson to be near his family. Lee enjoyed fishing, hunting and playing cards. He read the Bible every day, and spent many hours watching tv. Lee embraced the retired life and always said that his greatest accomplishment in life was his kids, they were everything to him.
