Louis Wayne McIntosh, age 63, of Fort Gibson, Oklahoma entered his heavenly home on January 12, 2024. Louis was born October 6, 1960 in Oklahoma City, OK to Alvin & Vera (Burnett) McIntosh.

Louis lived most of his life in Fort Gibson, OK and attended the Oklahoma School for the Blind in Muskogee from elementary school up to graduating in 1980. He lived on campus throughout the week which he loved because most of his friends lived there also. Most of all, he liked to hang out with his best friend, Phillip Rotramel, often getting into mischief because they apparently weren't always the best influence on each other.

After graduating, Louis also attended Arkansas Enterprises for the Blind for a short time, then returned home to Fort Gibson. In the early 90's, Louis was able to live in town at the bait shop owned by his parents, Big Al's Fishin' Shak. This allowed him to ride his bicycle around town which gave him an independence he didn't always have due to his poor vision. This was also around the time he started attending Valley View church and attending prayer meetings with Sister Lee Johnson, "who would give the devil hell". Louis loved going to church, and according to his dad, "Louis would go to church anytime the doors were open". He remained a faithful member of Valley View church until his death.

Because of his health issues, Louis held few jobs in his lifetime, but was always ready and willing to lend a hand. Louis loved his family fiercely and loved being able to play with his nieces and nephews when they were kids.

He especially loved it when he was able to help his mom with babysitting his niece, Jesi, and also loved getting to have fun times with his great niece, Reagan. Louis loved getting hugs from Chase, Riley, and Emma and he also loved getting hugs from his church family.

Louis enjoyed visiting with family, friends, and even total strangers, and enjoyed reminiscing about the good old days, especially when a good country meal was included. He would share jokes, fun facts, and interesting articles with friends & family through email, and enjoyed staying in contact with his high school alumni group. He also enjoyed watching old tv shows, but mostly he loved playing on his Iphone, either online boardgames on goldtoken or reading and posting on Facebook. He was always excited about going swimming or fishing in the summer, but didn't get to do either nearly as often as he wanted. Louis loved to laugh and always enjoyed hearing a good joke and telling one, even off-color ones every now and then. He'll be remembered for his big heart, great smile, joyful laugh, and his Christian faithfulness.

Louis is survived by his brothers, James, of the home, Kenneth & wife, Sandi, of Hitchita, OK, sister, Alma & husband, Charlie, of Dover, OK, nephews, Cory McIntosh & wife, Corrina, Kenny McIntosh & wife Jessica, nieces, Bailey Crossland, and Jesi Pickle; great nieces and nephews, Reagan, Chase, Rylee, Emma, Colton, Abby and Gunner, his beloved cat, Samantha, as well as numerous extended family and friends.
