Mark McClellan Jones, 63, was born January 30, 1952 in Long Beach, California to Olen Francis and Anita (Tankersley) Jones and passed away peacefully, Thursday, August 6, 2015 in Tulsa with his loving family by his side.

Mark attended schools in California and lost his Mom at an early age. Faced with diversity and many challenges, Mark joined the United States Marine Corps on February 24, 1969. 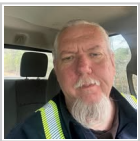

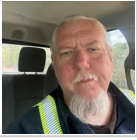

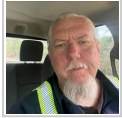
