Myrtle M. 'Punkie' (Henderson) Staton, 80, of Muskogee was born June 15, 1939 in Fort Cobb, OK to Alphonso Creed and Cora Mae (Hardesty) Henderson and received her eternal reward on Saturday, February 15, 2020 in Muskogee with her loving family by her side.

Myrtle grew up in Fort Gibson where she received her formal education. She received her nickname 'Punkie' as a young girl and if ever asked, it was her real name. She met and later married the love of her life for 61 years, Thomas Arthur Staton on August 16, 1958 in Fort Gibson. He preceded her in death on Sunday, November 24, 2019.

Myrtle was a homemaker by choice but on occasions would work outside the home as a bookkeeper and office clerk for the MFA Feed Store and tax preparer for H & R Block. 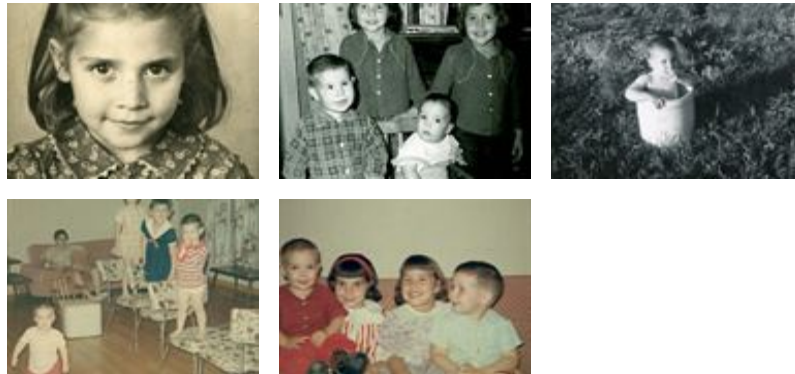

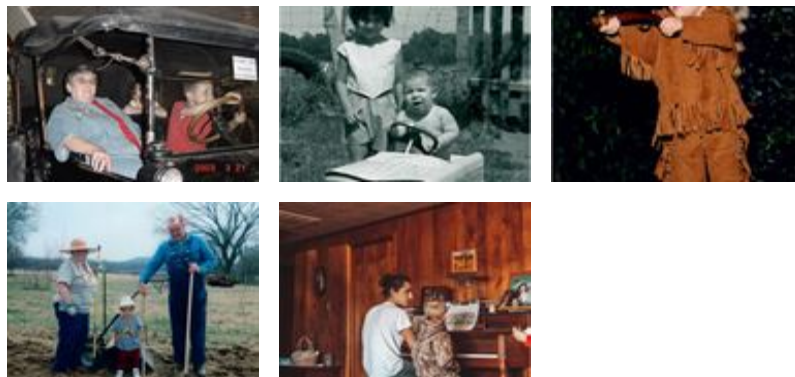
