Patsy Sue (Hamlin) White, 94, of Fort Gibson, OK was born November 4, 1931, in Fort Smith, AR to Harry and Rena (Self) Hamlin. She joined her husband, Henry, and her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Friday, January 2, 2026, in Muskogee.

Raised in Fort Gibson, Pat graduated from Fort Gibson High School before enlisting in the United States Army on May 17, 1951, in Tulsa. She served as a Secretary/Bookkeeper after completing Clerk-Typist School and was honorably discharged from Camp Cook, California, on October 17, 1952.

On July 23, 1955, Pat married her best friend, Henry White, in Tahlequah, Oklahoma. With her clerk-typist training, she began her professional journey with Griffin Grocery, where she retired after 25 years. Following her retirement, she worked an additional five years at Mako (7-11 stores). In

addition, Pat and Henry enjoyed a total of 27 years serving the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Porum Landing as gate attendants and volunteers. Pat was deeply involved in her community.
