Phillip (Phil) Franklin Berry was born in Oklahoma City, OK, on October 28, 1936, and passed away on June 3, 2024, at his home in Muskogee, OK. He attended Oklahoma State University. He and his brother owned and operated Berry Equipment Company in Muskogee, OK. Phil later owned Phil Berry Excavating until his retirement.

When Phil found himself interested in something new, he didn't just dabble—he immersed himself fully in whatever he was pursuing.
