Robert Anthony Cuadrado, Sr., 89, of Tulsa, OK was born June 3, 1935 to Santos and Marina (Santos) Cuadrado in Bronx, NY and peacefully passed away Monday, July 8, 2024 in Tulsa, OK.

Robert grew up in New York and graduated from the Manhattan School of Music. He enlisted in the United States Navy on October 28, 1952 and proudly served his country until May 29, 1956, when he was honorably discharged. Robert was an accomplished musician, playing alongside many well-known artists. He also had 2 Masters Degrees from the University of Oklahoma. Robert loved spending time with his family and friends. He will be dearly missed.

Robert is preceded in death by his parents, Santos and Marina Cuadrado; and his brother, Johnny.

Those left to cherish Robert's memory are his son, Robert Cuadrado, Jr. of Argyle, TX; his daughter, Michelle Cuadrado of Tulsa, OK; sisters, Julie Russell, and Francis Arroyo, several aunts; cousins; nieces; extended family; and many friends.

We shared many good times together, especially with the family (mostly nieces lol) eating, drinking, dancing (he was the best salsa dancer), talking into the wee hours (cosmic shits), and we enjoyed all kinds of music together. Bob had an easy way about him with a great sense of humor.

He was an accomplished student with two master's degrees, a teacher of music and language, and a musician extraordinaire having played bass with popular salsa bands of the day in the 50s, jazz and pop in the 60s (including Jose Feliciano) and blue grass bands in the 70s, recording with Mountain Smoke with Vince Gil – “On Blue Ridge.” Bob formed his own jazz band in the 80s, called “Night Flight” and a Salsa band in the 2000s, called “Salsa Rhythm Project”. All the while he taught music and Spanish at Universities of Oklahoma and Tulsa, which also included many private students; youngsters taking Spanish, piano and guitar lessons. I just can't say enough about how proud we all are of him and his accomplishments. He was the best example of what a person from a poor background could achieve! God Bless you Big Brother!!

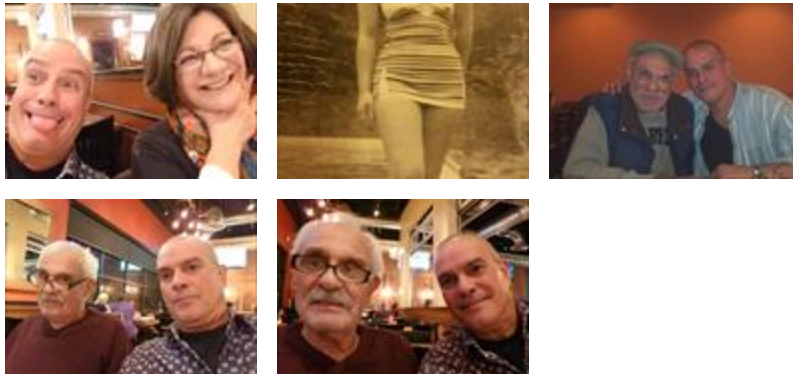

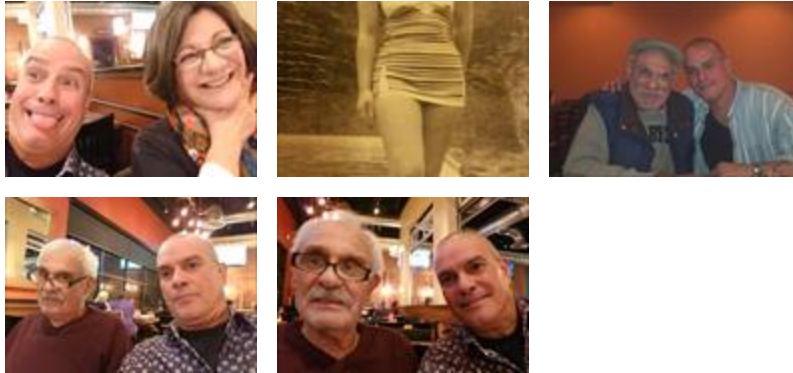

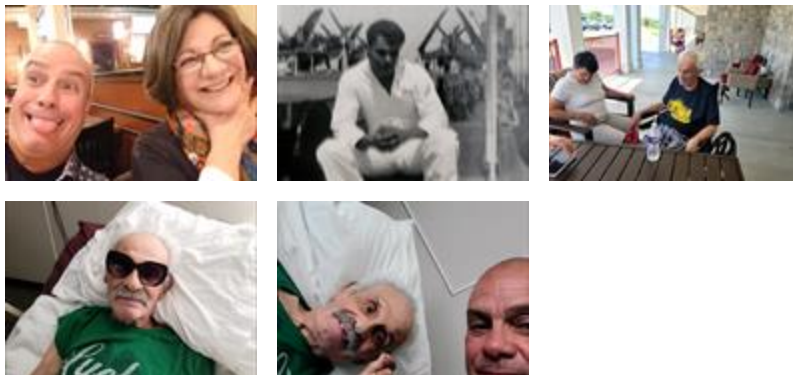
