Ronald Hulan Trimm, 72, of Tahlequah, OK, died June 23, 2022, at Saint Francis Hospital in Tulsa, OK.

A service with military honors will be held at Fort Gibson National Cemetery on Tuesday, June 28th at 12:30PM.

Ron was born in Winfield, AL on November 25, 1949, to Robert and Gaitha Trimm.

Ron served in the US Army and is a veteran of the Vietnam War. He was awarded two Purple Hearts for combat injuries as well as the Bronze Star Medal and Army Commendation Medal for valor. He was proud of his service along with the enduring, close friendships he maintained with his fellow veterans. Following his military service, he completed his undergraduate degree at the University of South Carolina.

He was incredibly outgoing and enjoyed making people laugh and turning strangers into friends. His personality served him well in his career in sales, business, and real estate. He loved to travel and explore, literally driving millions of miles on back roads and wearing out many, many cars.
