Sharon (Kay-Kay) Short, 53, of Fort Gibson, peacefully passed away August 29, 2015 in Tulsa, Oklahoma with her family by her side. She was born September 19, 1961 in Muskogee, Oklahoma, to Roy and Imogene Robins. Sharon graduated from Muskogee High School with the class of 1980. She married Roger Short on July 13, 1991 in Muskogee, Oklahoma.

Sharon loved to laugh and to make others laugh. She was actively involved in her church at First Baptist often helping during vacation bible school, cooking and baking for church members and would have cookouts at her home for the Bacone Ministry. She loved reading her Bible and studied scriptures daily. Her favorite Bible verse was Ephesians 2:8. She loved Hummingbirds and enjoyed watching them through the glass in the front door while they were feeding from her feeder. She loved to help anyone in need and would have gladly given the shirt off her back to anyone. She always put everyone else's needs before her own often going without in the process.
